## BIBLE QUOTES ?????

Often, one shall present something they think is in the Bible; but in reality is not in the book. Many have been the times I have been approached and ask, "Where in the Bible is that found?" Many have been the times when I have just stated ..... "That is not in the Bible;" it is not uncommon for someone to challenge me and say: "How do you know it is not in the Bible?" Well, for one reason, I have read the Bible through a number of times and do not ever remember seeing it in the Book. I am thinking most people feel towards me as they do toward themselves, they have not read the entirety of the Bible; so, they think you have not either! Also, many of the quotes they make I have tried to find, have looked care-fully and came to know that

such a quote is not in the book. All of such explanations do not keep some folks from continuing to quote what the book does not say and attributing it to the Bible – they think this gives them creditability! Because, someone says their quote is from the Bible does not make it so!

“CLEANLINESS IS NEXT TO GODLINESS:” This is a quote that is believed by many to be true – from the Bible; but, it is not. It may well be the principle is true; but that quote is not in the book. The Bible teaches we are not to lie, curse, murder, fornicate, etc; yet, there are many people who do not violate the word by doing such things – they are not Christians and do not chose to become such. This is just the life they have chosen. God is not motivating what they do; this is their choice and thus are the doctrines and precepts of men, Matt. 15:8-9.

“AN IDLE MIND IS THE DEVIL'S WORK SHOP:” There is a passage in the New Testament that is almost the same; but, not quite the same as stated: “13 And withal they learn also to be idle, going about from house to house; and not only idle, but tattlers also and busybodies, speaking things which they ought not,” I Tim. 5:13. In a sense one could say this passage is teaching “An idle mind is the devil's work shop;” but that statement is not found in the Bible. Here again, we find a statement quoted by many and attributed to the Bible; yet, this statement is not found in the Bible!

“BAPTISM HAS NOTHNG TO DO WITH A PERSON'S SALVATION!” This statement is being used as if the Bible taught, somewhere, that BAPTISM has nothing to do with one's salvation! Recently, I was told this and when I asked where in the Bible was there teaching to the effect that baptism had nothing to do with one's salvation, they could not produce a passage that taught such. The Bible teaches baptism “UNTO” the remission of sins, Acts 2:38, in the Greek language the word is “unto,” the remission of sins; In the King James Version of Rom. 6:3 and Gal. 3:27, the expression “INTO CHRIST,” is used. If one is “baptized into Christ,” that would mean if he has not been baptized for the right purpose, he is not in Christ; In Acts 22:16 Saul of Tarsus was told, “16 .... be baptized, and wash away thy sins,” This passage is teaching, if one has not been baptized for the right purpose he has not had his sins washed away; When one scripturally baptized “he arises to walk In newness of life,” Rom. 6:4; In I Pet 3:21 we are told: “21which also after a true likeness doth now save you, even baptism.” What the Bible says about baptism is quite different than that which is taught by Baptist preachers. One cannot appeal to the Bible to show baptism does not save, the Bible does not so teach!

Now, this is just a few of the claims made by the world, that these are teachings of the Bible. Before you believe such, one should investigate what the Bible does teach concerning such subjects. When one becomes acquainted with the Bible he will notice there are many claims being made that are not of the teachings of the Bible and should be avoided.

I am thinking we need to become students of the Bible and learn what is and is not found in God's book!
