7 Things to Remember During the Lord's Supper

1. One Lord – “There is one Lord” Eph. 4:5
2. Two thieves – “There were also two others, criminals, led with Him to be put to death.” Lk. 23:42
3. Three crosses – Lk. 23:39-43
4. Four parts of His garments – “Then the soldiers, when they had crucified Jesus, took His garments and made four parts, to each soldier, a part, and also the tunic.” Jn. 19:32
5. Five wounds – His back was scourged, head was crowned with thorns, hands and feet were pierced and side was cut opened. Jn. 19:1-2, 34; Psalm 22:16
6. Six hours of agony – He was crucified on the 3rd hour and died in the 9th hour Mk. 15:25-37
7. Seven statements spoke by Christ – Matt. 27:46; Lk. 23:34, 43-46; Jn. 19:26-30

What Must I do to be Saved?

Learn the Truth (hear) - Jn. 8:32, 17:17; Rom 10:17
Believe in Christ – Jn. 8:24, 20:31; Heb 11:6
Repent of all sins – Lk. 13:3; Acts 17:30; Rom 2:4
Confession of Faith – Acts 17:30; Rom 10:10
Baptism – Act 2:38, 22:16

Integrity is not for sale! If you find it on sale, it is counterfeit. IT AIN'T REAL!

Our integrity must be strong enough to stand alone. Study the following examples of God's faithful.

(Job 2:3) The LORD said to Satan, "Have you considered My servant Job? For there is no one like him on the earth, a blameless and upright man fearing God and turning away from evil. And he still holds fast his integrity, although you incited Me against him to ruin him without cause." (NAS95) Job held fast to his integrity even as God allowed Satan to try to separate him from God. He held fast to his integrity, lest he should lose it, Satan should take it from him.

(Job 27:5) "Far be it from me that I should declare you right; Till I die I will not put away my integrity from me." We can see how determined he was to hold fast, and not put away his integrity, it is part of who he is.

(Job 31:6) "Let Him weigh me with accurate scales, and let God know my integrity." Job has been tested [measured on scales] Let God declare the sincerity of his life. Psa. 25:21, 26:1

The glory of Job's character was his sincerity and uprightness, which is integrity.

(Daniel 6:4) "Then the commissioners and satraps began trying to find a ground of accusation against Daniel in regard to government affairs; but they could find no ground of accusation or evidence of corruption, inasmuch as he was faithful, and no negligence or corruption was to be found in him." This is an example of integrity.

(Genesis 39:9) "There is no one greater in this house than I, and he has withheld nothing from me except you, because you are his wife. How then could I do this great evil and sin against God?"

Think about what Joseph's integrity cost him. A plum position of responsibility in Potiphar's house, he oversaw everything except Potiphar's wife. However, the overriding element was Joseph's commitment to serve Jehovah, the God of Israel and of all the earth. If he had sinned it would have been against God. We must never forget that fact!

Consider Solomon's integrity in I Kings 8: 54-61, (1 Kings 8:56-58) "Blessed be the LORD, who has given rest to His people Israel, according to all that He promised; not one word has failed of all His good promise, which He promised through Moses His servant. "May the LORD our God be with us, as He was with our fathers; may He not leave us or forsake us, that He may incline our hearts to Himself, to walk in all His ways and to keep His commandments and His statutes and His ordinances, which He commanded our fathers. His uprightness, sincerity, and honesty are before God and the assembled nation of Israel."

(1 Kings 8:61) "Let your heart therefore be wholly devoted to the LORD our God, to walk in His statutes and to keep His commandments, as at this day." This is integrity!!!
